## "Men God Gave Moses" Biblical Examples of the 'Seven Spheres of Support' (Exodus 16-18)

In a recent "E-Team" edition we looked at the seven spheres of support every leader needs. A great Biblical example of this concept is found in the life of Moses. As we look at the people the Lord placed in his life, we get a much better understanding of how God could use his life in such powerful ways. As we read his life story, we see these spheres of support represented by:

- \* Zipporah—a Mate to share the life journey with him.
- \*<u>Aaron</u>—a *Brother* to speak for him and stand with him.
- \* Aaron & Hur-- Intercessors to pray for him and encourage him.
- \* Joshua—an Apprentice to train and invest in.
- \* Jethro-a Mentor for wisdom and counsel.

\* <u>Hobab</u>—a *Guide* who knows the way ahead and who could *Sponsor* Moses to other people they would meet on the journey. (Num 10:29ff)

\* <u>The 70</u>- a *Community and Team of Leaders* to worship & experience God ...share the load and accomplish God's dream together! (Num 24)

Who fits these roles in your own journey? As you identify them, take time to thank God for them...and then take time to thank them for their influence in your life!

One of the most important things my father ever said to me was this: "Son, never forget to say *thank you*." Your appreciation for their investment in your life may mean more than you know!
